LEARNING EXPERIENCES IN OTHER PROGRAMS



SPANISH

Primary

- Play games to teach vocabulary
- Sing songs in Spanish
- Count to 40
- Learn Spanish alphabet
- Learn vocabulary: colors, calendar terms, holidays, animals
- Basic greetings

Intermediate

- Play games that teach vocabulary
- Listen to and read Spanish stories
- Describe weather and talk about the calendar
- Learn vocabulary: food, community home, school, holidays, and bodies
- Engage in simple conversations

Upper Elementary

- Students increase their vocabulary as they practice communication skills
- Grammar and sentence structure concepts are learned
- Students read and write in Spanish
- Students learn rules of verb conjugation at they create sentences with increasing independence

Spanish, Music, Phy-Ed, Art and Technology are offered at all grade levels.



TECHNOLOGY - Computer Class

Primary

- Students learn to use various input devices; keyboard, mouse, and scanner
- Students learn to open programs, Access files, and save files
- Students learn to use Microsoft Word and PowerPoint

Intermediate

- Students continue to use Microsoft Word and PowerPoint building upon primary skills
- Microsoft Excel is introduced
- Students create graphs and charts
- Students learn to use the Internet to conduct research
- Students are introduced to Badgerlink. Learning to use this online data base as a research tool
- Advanced search skills are explored

Upper Elementary

- Students become critical thinkers as they evaluate web pages
- Students learn that the computer is a tool to further their learning

- Students use Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Publisher and begin to use Access
- New technologies are explored as they become available in the ever evolving field of technology



MUSIC

Kindergarten

Basic musical concepts through song and movement

Primary

Build upon concepts taught in kindergarten which include:

- Steady beat
- Rhythm
- Melody

Intermediate

Build upon concepts taught at the primary level through examples, song and written notation

Upper Grades

Focus on skill development of musical concepts through song, examples, written notation and performance
